

More Beaver flood barrier for flooded Eichenau



The rustic Starzelbach creek runs straight through the centre of Eichenau, near Munich in southern Germany. After sustained rainfall during May and June the Starzelbach rapidly turned into a torrent and threatened many historic homes in the centre of town. Quickly 200 metres of the orange Beaver was deployed which prevented substantial damage to buildings and infrastructure. Hence another money saving deployment.

Evaluation after the flooding:

- 200 metres of Beaver was not enough to fully protect Eichenau so Eichenau ordered another 150 metres.
- Neighbouring villages, after fighting the same flood with large quantities of sandbags, have now included Beaver in next years budget.
