Yes, the Poms were hit by floods again, it seems to become a yearly event now and luckily they have the gear to deal with floods.

Last December big tides overflowed the 3 meters flood barrier, creating a lake of floodwater near Alkborough Flatts. Hytrans mobile high volume pumps helped to pump the millions of litres of water back into the River Humber and Trent.

Regular and severe flooding in the UK has resulted in close cooperation between different Fire & Rescue stations, water utilities, EPA and other emergency services. Flood knowledge is pooled and valuable lessons learnt. In Alkborough Flatts the Humberside Fire and Rescue, the Environment Agency and Severn Trent Water worked successfully together. Obviously more successful than the touring English Cricket team...

Hytrans mobile large capacity flood pumps (on trailer, skid or hook lift) have easy water access and can be deployed quickly with 2 persons positioning the submersible pump in the water. The hydraulically driven submersible pump then pushes the water into the flexible hose; no suction or priming. Pumping capacity is up to a backyard swimming pool every minute (50,000 lit/min).
