Manhattan skyscrapers do not come cheap.

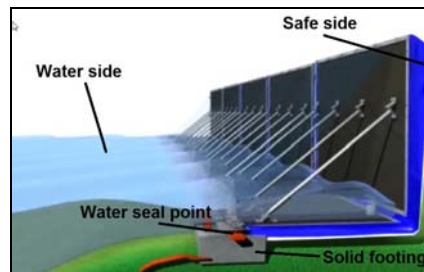
When the 2012 Superstorm Sandy flooded the ground floors of many high rise buildings, the damage was massive and tenants considered moving out.
