

Swiss Army Rescue Forces and their flood gear



High mountains, glaciers, roaring water streams, lakes and rivers.

Switzerland has it all: flash flooding and riverine flooding.

Accessing the floodwater to help can be a challenge while there is a need to quickly pump out the flooded areas; buildings, cellars, carparks and tunnels.

The Swiss Army Rescue Forces are often called in to limit the misery to people, the damage to assets and the resulting economic losses. Water is re-directed and pumped out over considerable distances using 152mm hoses and high volume flood pumps.

The [Hytrans HS150 flood pump](#) (50,000 lit per min = more than 1 backyard swimming pool) has a proven track record of many years.

The Swiss-made [Beaver](#), orange water filled twin-tube barrier, are the most popular mobile flood barriers and are often used in combination with Hytrans pumps.

On top of their earlier order for 40 Hytrans units more than a decade ago, Hytrans has now delivered 26 additional HS150 units with 78 high volume submersible pumps to the Swiss Army Rescue Forces with a special relay pumping module.
